Updates on fundraisers

Sign update: 27 signs have been ordered and more will be available should anyone else like to order one.

Fun Run/Walk : The fun run/walk was held and there were approximately 106 people who participated. This was down from last year. We had moved the run to an evening run and that may have had an impact due to it being so hot out. We received approximately \$5,000 in donations and \$3,000 in

registrations. Expenses were approximately \$2,000 this had us at a net profit of \$6,000 with a donation to the cancer center remaining. There is also enough colored powder left over for next year's run as well as enough bags so this will reduce the cost for next year's event dramatically should we decide to have one.

Apparel update: There was approximately 15 orders put in for the Sparkle City clothing order with 21 items ordered. Items still can be ordered but at the regular price. There will no longer be a discounted price since the due date has expired. A total number of items purchased off of the Dakota Screen Arts website is not known at this time but sales picked up dramatically the last week.

The online store may be opened once again but for only three days. But there will be no guarantee on delivery. Information will come out if it does open.

Scheels is donating a signed Greg Eslinger football on a tee with case to use as a silent auction item along with 50/50 fundraisers at meet and greet!!

Volunteers will be needed for the meet and greet. It will be on August 21. Set up time will be between 3 and 4 pm. Please come and help if you are available.

Coca Cola donated water and Powerade for the meet and greet and Frito Lay donated the chips.

Spirit Committee— Items have been ordered to throw out at the games such as Frisbee's, water bottles and Footballs. All have the Demon logo on them to help promote the spirit of our school and team. Discussion was brought up on the fact that Principal Wisthoff does not want these items thrown out due to the possibility of students throwing them at each other and throwing them out towards the field. It was discussed on possibly handing them out at half time.

An example would be the drama club leading one game and the science club leading a different game. This will be discussed further with the school administration.
